



REDUCING CROSS-CONTAMINATION

The eight-sided fold methodology for microfibre cloths helps maximise the use of the cloth while reducing the risk of cross-contamination during the cleaning process.



1 BEGIN with open, clean Microfibre cloth



2 FOLD Microfibre cloth in half



3 FOLD Microfibre cloth in quarters



4 CLEAN surfaces with two exposed sides of cloth



5 OPEN Microfibre cloth once to change sides



6 REFOLD to expose two fresh cleaning sides



7 OPEN cloth fully once four sides have been used






8 REPEAT steps 2 through 7 to use all eight sides

TIP

Always track sides being used to prevent cross-contamination

Colour-coding can help prevent cross-contamination. The below colours are commonly used within different areas of a facility per industry guidelines.*

-  General Cleaning
-  Food Service & Food Preparation Areas
-  Bathroom/Toilets/Dirty Utility Rooms
-  Infectious & Isolation Areas
