The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends the following preventative actions to stop the spread of germs.

CLEAN ROUTINELY

The flu virus can live and potentially infect a person up to 48 hours after being deposited on a surface.⁴ Cleaning routinely can help remove the virus.
