CLEANING CARTS IMPROVE EMPLOYEE EFFICIENCY & SAFETY

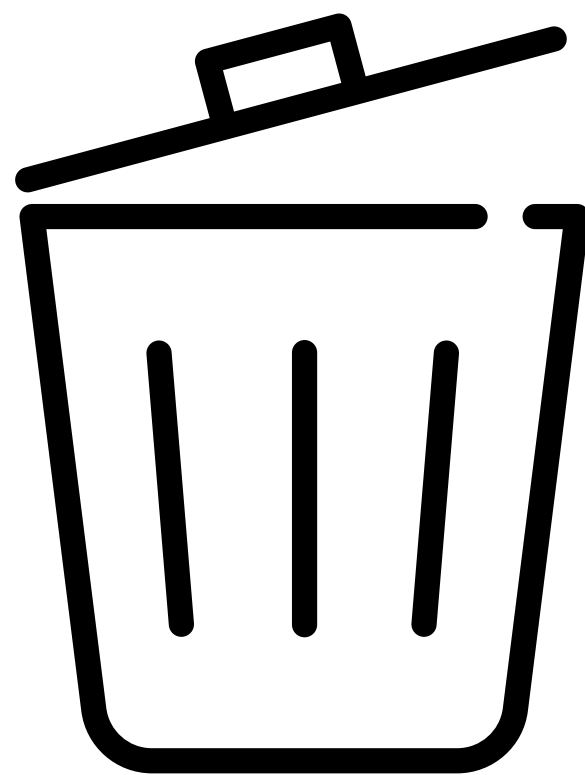

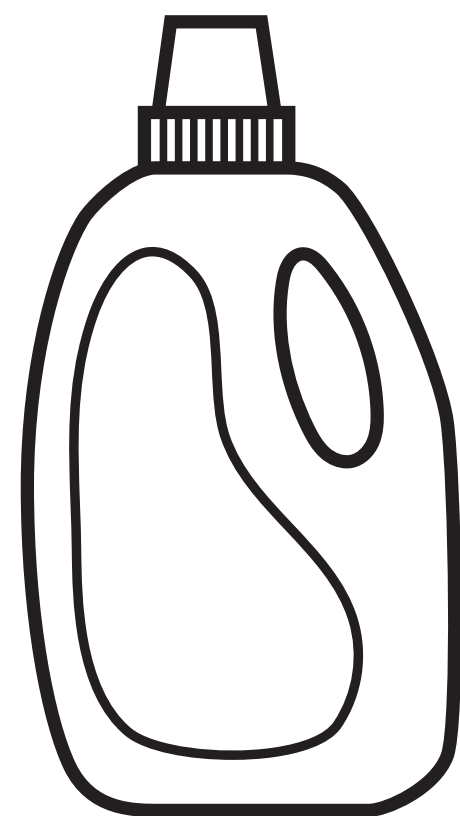

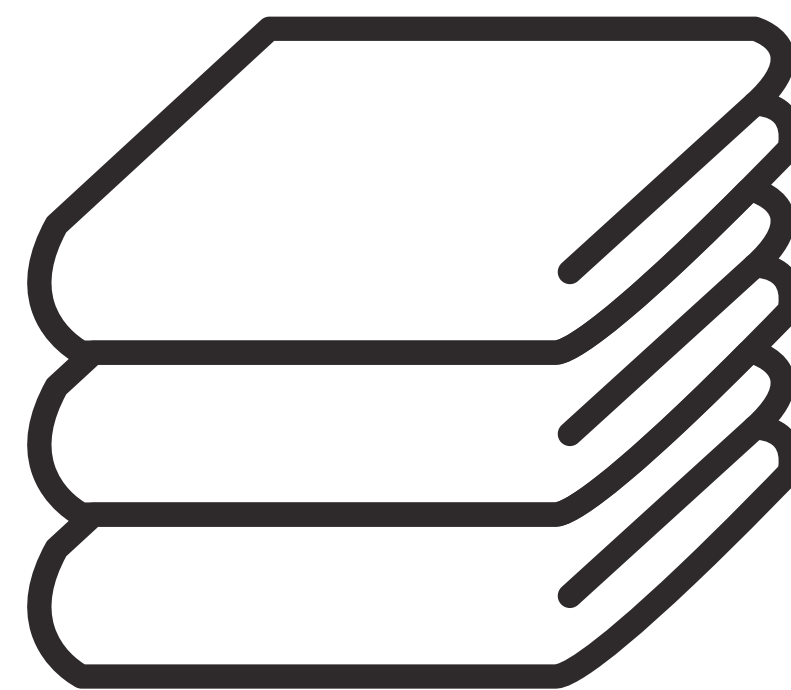
There is no limitation to what resources cleaning carts can carry. However, here are some of the most common:



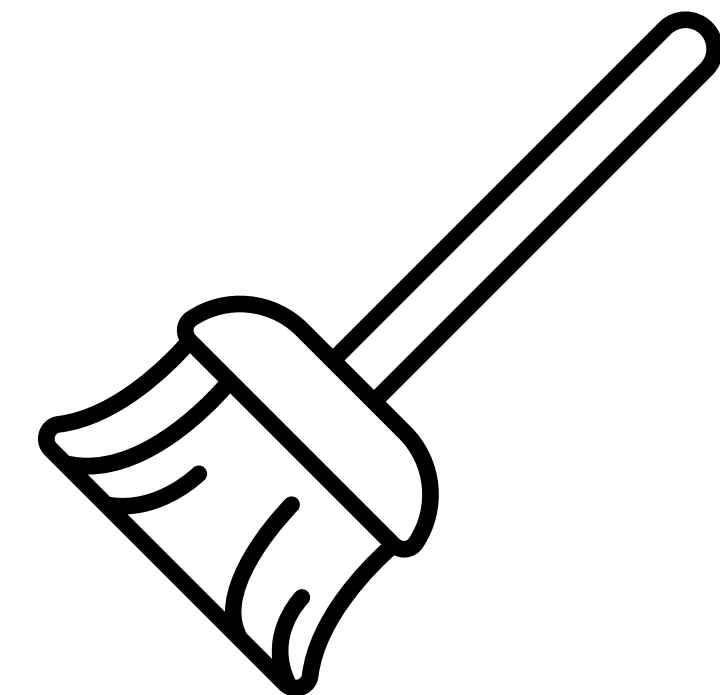
Waste Bins
