

MOPPING BEST PRACTICES

PREPARATION AND SETUP

- Wear proper personal protective equipment, gloves, and eye protection (as recommended by chemical's MSDS) while dispensing chemical.
- Fill the WaveBrake® Mop Bucket with diluted floor cleaning solution as recommended per chemical-specified guidelines.
- Attach a clean Maximizer Mop head to the handle. The Maximizer Mop will work with an Invader or Gripper handle.
- ☐ Dip the Maximizer Mop head into the diluted cleaning solution toward the front of the WaveBrake® Mop Bucket until it is saturated.


DUST MOPPING

- Inspect area to be cleaned. Remove movable items such as trash cans and light furniture.
- Dust mop or sweep area to remove all debris, dirt, and large objects from the mopping area.

MOPPING PROCESS

- Place safety signs on outer edge of area to be mopped.
- ☐ Move the mop head to the wringer, twist mop 1-2 times, and wring out the mop by pressing the handle of the wringer down.
- Repeat as necessary to dampen the mop until the mop head does not drip when raised from the wringer.
- ☐ Create an area to mop inside. Place the Maximizer Mop on the floor and frame out or create a comfortable work area with the mop, typically a 10' x 10' area.
- After framing, return to the farthest point from the exit. For best results, mop in a figure 8 motion while moving backwards. Fill in the box and repeat until entire area is cleaned. See Figure 1 for proper figure 8 motion.
- Frame out the next farthest box from your planned exit point and repeat the figure 8 pattern.
- Move safety signs as sections of the floor become dry and keep them on the front edge of any wet floor space.
- Repeat mopping process as necessary until the desired floor space is clean.

CHANGING CLEANING SOLUTION

☐ Return the WaveBrake® Mop Bucket

to the mop sink.
Wring out the mop by pressing the handle of the wringer down.
Remove the used mop head from the handle and take to onsite laundering facility for laundering and re-use. Replace with a clean Maximizer Mop.
Remove wringer from WaveBrake® Mop Bucket and rinse it with clean water.
Empty remaining contents of the mop bucket into the mop sink and rinse with clean water.
Replace the wringer at the back of the mop bucket
Fill the WaveBrake® Mop Bucket with new diluted floor cleaning solution as recommended per chemical-specified guidelines.

CLEANUP PROCESS

and return to storage.

Return WaveBrake® Mop Bucket to mop sink.
Remove Maximizer Mop and return to laundry facility for laundering and re-use.
Remove wringer and rinse with clean water.
Empty WaveBrake® Mop Bucket and rinse with clean water.
Replace the wringer at the back of mop bucket.
Return mop bucket and mop handle to storage.
Once floor is thoroughly dried, remove safety sign
