1 ANALYZE CURRENT WASTE AND RECYCLING PROCESSES


CONDUCT A WASTE AUDIT

OBJECTIVE:

 Collect, separate, and weigh each waste stream to understand how much is recycled versus how much is sent to the landfill

- What materials does your recycling service company collect for recycling?





HELPFUL HINT: If your recycling service company does not pick up a specific stream, search the Earth911.com database for additional recycling drop-off locations.






